

CAPTAIN FREDERICK L. PACK IV



Captain Frederick L. Pack IV is a member of the military faculty and the Director of Operations at the College of Information and Cyberspace, National Defense University, Fort Lesley J. McNair, DC. He oversees day-to-day operations for the college, including academic and program support and the 868 thousand dollar budget. Additionally, he has instructor duties for two courses within the college's curriculum.

Captain Pack enlisted in the Air Force in December 2002 and his background includes various duties as a computer programmer and a previous assignment at the White House Communications Agency. He attended both Troy University and the Florida Institute of Technology and commissioned in October of 2013 as a graduate of Officer Training School.

Captain Pack previously serves as the Chief of Cybersecurity for Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance Systems (ISR), Headquarters Air Force, Pentagon. He directed cyber security policy, oversight & guidance efforts for the ISR systems and centers that comprise the 55 billion dollar ISR information environment. Captain Pack also served as the Assistant Director of Operations, 693d Intelligence Support Squadron, Ramstein Air Base, Germany.

There he organized three flights of both military and civilian personnel delivering real-time Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance operations support for Africa Command, European Command, and Central Command. He oversaw cyberspace planning and execution supporting the 400 million dollar Air Force Distributed Common Ground System weapon system.

Since commissioning, Captain Pack has deployed twice serving in contingency roles. He deployed on a yearlong tour, from May 2016 to May 2017, as the Communications Branch Chief and Air Defense Liaison Team's Communication Officer at the Air Force Central Command's Air Warfare Center, Al Dhafra Air Base, United Arab Emirates. Additionally, he deployed as the Liaison Officer-Operating Location Alpha for the Persistent Attack and Reconnaissance Operations Center where he operations of satellite relay station.
